# TENTATIVE FORECAST OF THE PROGRAMME OF WORK OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL FOR THE MONTH OF AUGUST 2007

#### **AFRICA**

## **Chad and Central African Republic**

Resolution 1706 of 31 August 2006

As a follow-up to his report dated 23 February 2007 (S/2007/97), the Secretary-General will submit, in early August, a report on the talks and contacts carried out by his technical mission dispatched to Chad and the CAR, as well as the revised concept for a UN Mission in eastern Chad and northeastern CAR.

#### **Democratic Republic of the Congo - Sanctions**

Resolution 1768 (2007) of 31 July 2007

Decides to extend the measures on arms, transport, finance and travel until 10 August 2007.

#### Liberia - UNMIL

Resolution 1750 (2007) of 30 March 2007

Para. 3: requests the Secretary-General to present a detailed drawdown plan for the United Nations Mission in Liberia (UNMIL) in his next report to the Security Council, which should be presented no later than 45 days prior to the expiration of UNMIL's mandate.

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued by 16 August 2007.

## Somalia - AMISOM

Resolution 1744 (2007) of 20 February 2007

Para. 4: decides to authorize member States of the African Union to establish <u>for a period</u> <u>of six months</u> a mission in Somalia.

The authorization of AMISOM by the Security Council will expire on 20 August 2007.

#### The Sudan – sanctions

Resolution 1713 (2006) of 29 September 2006

Para.2: requests the Panel of Experts to provide a final report to the Security Council with its findings and recommendations no later than 30 days prior to the termination of its mandate.

The Panel of Experts is expected to provide its final report to the Council <u>by 30 August</u> 2007.

#### The Sudan - UNMIS

Resolution 1755 (2007) of 30 April 2007

Para. 2: requests the Secretary-General to report to the Security Council <u>every three months</u> on the implementation of the mandate of the United Nations Mission in the Sudan (UNMIS).

The report of the Secretary-General is expected in the beginning of August.

#### The Sudan – Darfur monthly report

Resolution 1590 (2005) of 24 March 2005

Para.12: requests that the Secretary-General continue to report on a monthly basis on the situation in Darfur.

The Secretary-General's report is expected to be issued <u>during August 2007</u>.

## The Sudan - UNAMID

Resolution 1769 (2007) of 31 July 2007

Para. 6: *Requests* the Secretary General to report to the Council within 30 days of the passage of this resolution and every 30 days thereafter, on the status of UNAMID's implementation of the steps specified in paragraph 5.

#### **AMERICAS**

#### Haiti – MINUSTAH

#### Resolution 1743 (2007) of 15 February 2007

Para. 23: requests the Secretary-General to report to the Security Council on the implementation of the mandate of the United Nations Stabilization Mission in Haiti (MINUSTAH) <u>not later than 45 days prior to its expiration</u>.

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued by 1 September 2007.

#### ASIA

# Iraq - UNAMI

Resolution 1700 (2006) of 10 August 2006

Para. 2: expresses its intention to review the mandate of the United Nations Assistance Mission for Iraq (UNAMI) in 12 months, or sooner if requested by the Government of Iraq.

The Security Council is expected to conduct a review of the UNAMI mandate <u>by 10 August</u> 2007.

Para. 1: decides to extend the UNAMI mandate for another <u>period of 12 months</u> from the date of the resolution.

The UNAMI mandate will expire on 10 August 2007.

# The situation in the Middle East, including the Palestinian Question

Resolution 1322 (2000) of 7 October 2000

Para. 7: invites the Secretary-General to continue to follow the situation and to keep the Security Council informed.

#### Middle East – Lebanon (UNIFIL)

Resolution 1701 (2006) of 1 August 2006

Para. 16: decides to extend the mandate of the United Nations Interim Force in Lebanon (UNIFIL) until 31 August 2007.

The UNIFIL mandate will expire on 31 August 2007.

A meeting between the Security Council and the troop-contributing countries will take place prior to the expiration of the UNIFIL mandate.

#### Middle East – Lebanon (resolution 1757 (2007))

Resolution 1757 (2007) of 30 May 2007

Para. 3: requests the Secretary-General, in coordination, when appropriate, with the Government of Lebanon, to undertake the steps and measures necessary to establish the Special Tribunal in a timely manner and to report to the Security Council within 90 days.

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued by 28 August 2007.

#### Timor-Leste - UNMIT

Resolution 1745 (2007) of 22 February 2007

Para. 14: requests the Secretary-General to submit a report which includes recommendations for possible adjustments in the mandate and strength of the United Nations Integrated Mission in Timor-Leste (UNMIT) to the Security Council within 60 days after the Presidential and Parliamentary elections.

The presidential elections having concluded on 9 May 2007 and the parliamentary elections having taken place on 30 June 2007, the report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued by 29 August 2007.
