## TENTATIVE FORECAST OF THE PROGRAMME OF WORK OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL FOR THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER 2007

#### For information only/not an official document

This tentative forecast of the programme of work of the Security Council has been prepared by the Secretariat for the President of the Council. The forecast covers in particular those matters that may be taken up during the month pursuant to earlier decisions of the Council. The fact that a matter is or is not included in the forecast carries no implication that it will or will not be taken up during the month: the actual programme of work will be determined by developments and the views of members of the Council.

## TENTATIVE FORECAST OF THE PROGRAMME OF WORK OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL FOR THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER 2007

#### **AFRICA**

#### Guinea-Bissau - UNOGBIS

Resolution 1580 (2004) of 22 December 2004

Para. 11: requests the Secretary-General to keep the Security Council closely and <u>regularly informed</u> of developments on the ground and of the implementation of the resolution and in that regard, to submit a report to the Council <u>every 3 months</u> from the date of the adoption of the resolution.

The Secretary-General's report is expected to be issued by 30 September 2007.

#### Liberia - UNMIL

Resolution 1750 (2007) of 30 March 2007

Para. 5: requests the Secretary-General to present a detailed drawdown plan for the United Nations Mission in Liberia (UNMIL) in his next report to the Security Council which should be presented no later than 45 days prior to the expiration of UNMIL's mandate.

The report of the Secretary-General dated 8 August 2007 (S/2007/479) is before the Security Council.

Para. 1: decides that the UNMIL mandate shall be extended until 30 September 2007.

The UNMIL mandate will expire on 30 September 2007.

A meeting between the Security Council and the troop-contributing countries will take place before the expiry of the UNMIL mandate.

#### Somalia - AMISOM / UN mission

Resolution 1772 (2007) of 20 August 2007

Para. 17: requests that the Secretary-General report to the Security Council within 30 days after the adoption of the resolution on the status of the further development of contingency planning for the possible deployment of a United Nations Peacekeeping Operation replacing the African Union Mission to Somalia (AMISOM), including the sending of a further Technical Assessment Mission to the region as soon as possible, as well as on the political aspects in paragraphs 6 and 7 of the resolution.

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued by 19 September 2007.

#### The Sudan - UNAMID

Resolution 1769 (2007) of 31 July 2007

Para. 6: requests the Secretary-General to report to the Security Council within 30 days of the passage of the resolution and every 30 days thereafter on the status of the implementation by the African Union-United Nations Hybrid Operation in Darfur (UNAMID) of the steps specified in paragraph 5 and on the extent of UNAMID's progress toward achieving full operational capability.

The report of the Secretary-General dated 30 August 2007 (S/2007/517) is before the Security Council.

The subsequent report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued <u>by 26 September 2007</u>.

#### The Sudan - Sanctions Committee

Resolution 1591 (2005) of 29 March 2005

Para. 3(a)(iv): decides that the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution1591 (2005) shall report at least <u>every 90 days</u> to the Security Council on its work.

The Chairman of the 1591 Committee is expected to report to the Security Council <u>during September 2007</u>.

#### The Sudan – Panel of Experts

Resolution 1713 (2006) of 29 September 2006

Para. 2: requests the Panel of Experts to provide to the Security Council a final report with its findings and recommendations no later than 30 days prior to termination of its mandate.

The report of the Panel of Experts is expected to be issued during September 2007.

Para.1: decides to extend <u>until 29 September 2007</u> the mandate of the Panel of Experts.

The mandate of the Panel of Experts will expire on 29 September 2007.

#### **AMERICAS**

#### Haiti – MINUSTAH

Resolution 1743 (2007) of 15 February 2007

Para. 23: requests the Secretary-General to report to the Security Council on the implementation of the mandate of the United Nations Stabilization Mission in Haiti (MINUSTAH) not later than 45 days prior to its expiration.

The report of the Secretary-General dated 23 August 2007 (S/2007/503) is before the Security Council.

#### **ASIA**

#### Afghanistan – UNAMA

Resolution 1662 (2006) of 23 March 2006

Para. 20: requests the Secretary-General to report to the Security Council <u>every 6 months</u> on developments in Afghanistan.

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued by 23 September 2007.

#### Iraq - UNMOVIC archives

Resolution 1762 (2007) of 29 June 2007

Para. 5: requests the Secretary-General to take all necessary measures to provide for the appropriate disposition of the archives and other property of the United Nations Monitoring, Verification and Inspection Commission (UNMOVIC) and to inform the Security Council within 3 months on steps taken in this regard.

The Secretary-General is expected to report to the Security Council by 29 September 2007.

#### Iraq – Oil-for-food

Letter by the Security Council President of 27 April 2007 (S/2007/242)

Penultimate para.: requests the Secretary-General to report to the Security Council <u>within 2</u> <u>months</u> on the progress made, and in that report to make specific recommendations regarding all outstanding issues.

The letter from the Secretary-General dated 25 July 2007 (S/2007/476) is before the Security Council.

#### The situation in the Middle East, including the Palestinian question

Resolution 1322 (2000) of 7 October 2000

Para. 7: invites the Secretary-General to continue to follow the situation and to keep the Security Council informed.

#### Middle East – Lebanon (resolution 1757 (2007))

Resolution 1757 (2007) of 30 May 2007

Para. 3: requests the Secretary-General, in coordination, when appropriate, with the Government of Lebanon, to undertake the steps and measures necessary to establish the Special Tribunal in a timely manner and to report to the Security Council within 90 days.

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued by 12 September 2007.

#### Timor-Leste - UNMIT

Resolution 1745 (2007) of 22 February 2007

Para. 14: requests the Secretary-General to submit a report which includes recommendations for possible adjustments in the mandate and strength of the United Nations Integrated Mission in Timor-Leste (UNMIT) to the Security Council within 60 days after the Presidential and Parliamentary elections.

The report of the Secretary-General dated 28 August 2007 (S/2007/513) is before the Security Council.

#### EUROPE

Resolutions 1160 (1998), 1199 (1998), 1203 (1998), 1239 (1999) and 1244 (1999) – UNMIK Resolution 1244 (1999) of 10 June 1999

Para. 20: requests the Secretary-General to report to the Security Council <u>at regular intervals</u> on the implementation of the resolution.

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued by 30 September 2007.

#### **OTHER**

#### Non-proliferation – Iran

Resolution 1737 (2006) of 23 December 2006

Para. 18(h) decides that the Committee established pursuant to resolution 1737 (2006) shall report <u>at least every 90 days</u> to the Security Council on its work and on the implementation of this resolution, with its observations and recommendations.

The Chairman of the 1737 Committee is expected to report to the Security Council <u>by 19 September 2007</u>.

#### Counter-terrorism – Al-Qaida/Taliban

Resolution 1735 (2006) of 22 December 2006

Annex II, para. (c): requests the Monitoring Team to submit to the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1267 (1999), in writing, a comprehensive, independent report, including specific recommendations for improved implementation of the measures referred to in paragraph 1 of the resolution and possible new measures, <u>by 30 September 2007</u>.

The Monitoring Team is expected to submit its report to the 1267 Committee <u>by 30 September 2007</u>.

Security Council Annual Report
The Security Council is expected to adopt its Annual Report for the period 1 August 2006 to 31 July 2007 at a formal meeting during September 2007.
