Letter dated 2 October 2007 from the Secretary-General to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to resolution 1771 (2007) concerning the Democratic Republic of the Congo, adopted on 10 August 2007, by which the Council requested me to re-establish, for a period expiring on 15 February 2008, the Group of Experts established pursuant to paragraph 10 of resolution 1533 (2004) and expanded pursuant to paragraph 21 of resolution 1596 (2005).
