Statement of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs to Georgia on developments in the Kodori Gorge

Given the recent developments in the Kodori Gorge, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Georgia underlines that the Georgian authorities are obliged to protect the interests of the population of the Kodori Gorge, ensuring their security and normal living conditions.

The Georgian authorities categorically rule out any kind of military operation on the territory of the Kodori Gorge and urge the population, distracted from the right path, to obey the law. In cases of disobedience, the Georgian authorities will exercise their legitimate right to carry out anti-criminal police operations similar to those targeted against organized crime in Kakheti, Imereti, Samegrelo and Svaneti.

The Georgian authorities also categorically rule out the extension of police operations to the territory controlled by the de facto Abkhazian authorities.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs is holding consultations with the United Nations, international organizations and other parties concerned on the developments in the Kodori Gorge.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs hopes that the world community and all parties concerned will approach with understanding the measures taken by the Georgian authorities in order to restore the rule of law in the Kodori Gorge.
