I write to you in relation to the heinous terrorist act which took the life of Member of Parliament Walid Eido, his son, two of his guards and a number of innocent civilians today in Beirut.

Based on the previous agreement between the International Independent Investigation Commission and the Lebanese Government, we hereby request technical assistance in the effort to investigate the murder of Member of Parliament Eido.
