## Letter dated 10 May 2011 from the Secretary-General to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 1973 (2011), by which the Council requested me to create, for an initial period of one year, in consultation with the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1970 (2011) concerning the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, a group of up to eight experts ("Panel of Experts") under the direction of the Committee, to carry out the tasks as specified in paragraph 24 of the resolution.

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that, after consulting with the Committee, I have decided to appoint the following experts:

Mr. Youseif Fahed Ahmed Alserhan, Jordan (maritime);
Mr. Oumar Dièye Sidi, Niger (customs);
Ms. Giovanna Perri, Italy (finance);
Mr. Salim Raad, Lebanon (arms: heavy weapons);
Ms. Savannah de Tessières, France (arms: small arms and light weapons);
Mr. Ahmed Zerhouni, Algeria (aviation).

I have designated Mr. Raad to serve as Coordinator of the Panel of Experts.

Two additional experts will be appointed shortly.

I should be grateful if you would bring this information to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
