Official communiqué of the 6750th (closed) meeting of the Security Council

**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Thursday,
12 April 2012, at 3.30 p.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“On 12 April 2012, the Security Council, pursuant to annex II, sections A and B of resolution 1353 (2001), held its 6750th meeting in private with the troop- and police- contributing countries to the United Nations Mission for the Referendum in Western Sahara.

“The Security Council and the troop- and police-contributing countries heard a briefing under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure by Mr. Wolfgang Weisbrod-Weber, Director of the Asia and Middle East Division of the Department of Peacekeeping Operations.

“Members of the Council, Mr. Weisbrod-Weber and representatives of participating contributing countries had an exchange of views.”
