**Letter dated 2 November 2005 from the Secretary-General
addressed to the President of the Security Council**

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 1630 (2005) of 14 October 2005 concerning Somalia. In paragraph 3 of that resolution, the Council requested me to re-establish, in consultation with the Committee established pursuant to resolution 751 (1992) concerning Somalia, within 30 days from the date of the adoption of the resolution, and for a period of six months, the Monitoring Group referred to in paragraph 3 of resolution 1558 (2004) to undertake the mandate set out in subparagraphs 3 (a) to (i) of resolution 1630 (2005).
