OFFICIAL COMMUNIQUÉ OF THE 4086TH MEETING OF
THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Held in private in the Security Council Chamber at Headquarters,
New York, on Thursday, 30 December 1999, at 10 a.m.

At its 4086th meeting, held in private on 30 December 1999, the Security Council considered Security Council resolutions 1160 (1998), 1199 (1998), 1203 (1998), 1239 (1999) and 1244 (1999). The representatives of Austria, Bangladesh, Belarus, Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cuba, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Egypt, Finland, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Italy, Luxembourg, Norway, Pakistan, Poland, Romania, Singapore, Slovakia, South Africa, Spain, Sweden, The former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Turkey and Ukraine were invited, at their request, to participate in accordance with rule 37 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure.

Mr. Vladislav Jovanovic was invited, at his request, to be seated at the Council table during the discussion.

The Permanent Observer of the Holy See to the United Nations was also invited, at his request, in accordance with the understanding reached in the Council's prior consultations, to participate.

The Security Council heard a briefing under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure by Mr. Hédi Annabi, Assistant Secretary-General for Peacekeeping Operations.

The members of the Council made comments and posed questions in connection with the briefing. Mr. Annabi responded to the comments and questions posed by members of the Council.
