Beirut, 19 April 2010

On the night of Saturday, 17 April 2010, at 9.30 p.m., an Israeli enemy motorized brigade assembled in occupied Palestinian territory near the Lebanese town of Udaysah and fired a flare shell over a civilian residence where a dinner party in honour of a local parliamentarian was being given. The shell exploded in the sky, causing fear and terror among the town's Lebanese citizens.

This Israeli aggression is a fundamental and blatant violation of Security Council resolution 1701 (2006) that raises tensions on both sides of the border. It is also another in a series of daily aggressions, violations and provocations that the Israeli enemy has persisted in committing since the adoption of resolution 1701 (2006), and a threat to international peace and security.
