Letter dated 20 August 2018 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution [2428 \(2018\)](#), by which the Council decided to extend until 1 July 2019 the mandate of the Panel of Experts on South Sudan, as set out in paragraph 18 of Council resolution [2206 \(2015\)](#) and paragraph 19 of resolution [2428 \(2018\)](#).

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that, after consulting with the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution [2206 \(2015\)](#) concerning South Sudan, I have appointed the following experts to serve on the Panel until 1 July 2019:

Michael Gibb (Norway), natural resources
Dean Gillespie (South Africa), arms
Andrei Kolmakov (Russian Federation), finance
Renifa Madenga (Zimbabwe), humanitarian affairs
Emilio Manfredi (Italy), armed groups/regional issues

I have designated Michael Gibb to serve as Coordinator of the Panel.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
