## TENTATIVE FORECAST OF THE PROGRAMME OF WORK OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL FOR THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER 2007

#### For information only/not an official document

This tentative forecast of the programme of work of the Security Council has been prepared by the Secretariat for the President of the Council. The forecast covers in particular those matters that may be taken up during the month pursuant to earlier decisions of the Council. The fact that a matter is or is not included in the forecast carries no implication that it will or will not be taken up during the month: the actual programme of work will be determined by developments and the views of members of the Council.

## TENTATIVE FORECAST OF THE PROGRAMME OF WORK OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL FOR THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER 2007

#### **AFRICA**

#### Burundi – BINUB

Resolution 1719 (2006) of 25 October 2006

Para. 14: requests the Secretary-General to keep the Security Council <u>regularly informed</u> of the progress of the United Nations Integrated Office in Burundi (BINUB) and on the implementation of the resolution, including with respect to the security situation and the human rights situation.

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued during November 2007.

#### Democratic Republic of the Congo - MONUC

Resolution 1756 (2007) of 15 May 2007

Para. 23: requests the Secretary-General to submit to the Security Council <u>by 15 November 2007</u> a report containing benchmarks and an indicative timetable for the gradual drawdown of the United Nations Organization Mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (MONUC).

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued by 15 November 2007.

A meeting between the Security Council and the troop-contributing countries will take place after the issuance of the report of the Secretary-General.

#### Eritrea / Ethiopia - UNMEE

Resolution 1320 (2000) of 15 September 2000

Para. 12: requests the Secretary-General to keep the Security Council <u>closely and regularly informed</u> of progress towards implementation of the resolution.

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued in early November 2007.

#### Sierra Leone - UNIOSIL

Resolution 1734 (2006) of 22 December 2006

Para. 12: requests the Secretary-General to keep the Security Council <u>regularly informed</u> of progress made in the implementation of the mandate of the United Nations Integrated Office in Sierra Leone (UNIOSIL) and this resolution.

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued by 30 November 2007.

#### Somalia - AMISOM / UN mission

Resolution 1772 (2007) of 20 August 2007

Para. 17: requests that the Secretary-General report to the Security Council <u>within a further 30 days</u> after his previous report on the status of the further development of contingency planning for the possible deployment of a United Nations peacekeeping operation replacing the African Union Mission to Somalia (AMISOM), including the sending of a further Technical Assessment Mission to the region, as well as on the political aspects in paragraphs 6 and 7 of the resolution.

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued in early November 2007.

#### The Sudan – UNAMID (30-day report)

Resolution 1769 (2007) of 31 July 2007

Para. 6: requests the Secretary-General to report to the Security Council <u>every 30 days</u> on the status of the implementation by the African Union-United Nations Hybrid Operation in Darfur (UNAMID) of the steps specified in paragraph 5 of the resolution and on the extent of UNAMID's progress toward achieving full operational capability.

Para. 5(a): decides that <u>no later than October 2007</u>, UNAMID shall establish an initial operational capability for the headquarters and shall establish financial arrangements to cover troop costs for all personnel deployed to the African Union Mission in the Sudan (AMIS).

Para. 5(b): decides that <u>as of October 2007</u>, UNAMID shall complete preparations to assume operational command authority over the Light Support Package, personnel currently deployed to AMIS, and such Heavy Support Package and hybrid personnel as may be deployed by that date.

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued by early November 2007.

#### The Sudan – UNAMID (90-day report)

Resolution 1769 (2007) of 31 July 2007

Para. 21: requests the Secretary-General to report to the Security Council for its consideration <u>no later than every 90 days</u> after the adoption of the resolution on progress being made on the implementation of the Light and Heavy Support Packages and UNAMID; the implementation of the Joint Communiqué between the Government of the Sudan and the United Nations on Facilitation of Humanitarian Activities in Darfur; the political process; the implementation of the Darfur Peace Agreement and the parties' compliance with their international obligations and their commitments under relevant agreements; and the ceasefire and the situation on the ground in Darfur.

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued by mid-November 2007.

#### ASIA

#### Iraq - UNMOVIC archives

Resolution 1762 (2007) of 29 June 2007

Para. 5: requests the Secretary-General to take all necessary measures to provide for the appropriate disposition of the archives and other property of the United Nations Monitoring, Verification and Inspection Commission (UNMOVIC) and to inform the Security Council within 3 months on steps taken in this regard.

The report of the Secretary-General dated 27 September 2007 (S/2007/568) is before the Security Council.

#### The situation in the Middle East, including the Palestinian question

By paragraph 7 of resolution 1322 (2000) of 7 October 2000, the Security Council invited the Secretary-General to continue to follow the situation and to keep the Council informed.

#### Middle East – Lebanon (resolution 1701 (2006))

Resolution 1773 (2007) of 24 August 2007

Para. 8: requests the Secretary-General to continue to report to the Security Council on the implementation of resolution 1701 (2007) every 4 months, or at any time as he deems appropriate.

The report of the Secretary-General dated 30 October 2007 (S/2007/641) is to be issued <u>in early November</u>.

#### Middle East – Lebanon (resolution 1559 (2004))

S/PRST/2004/36 of 19 October 2004

Last para.: requests the Secretary-General to report to the Security Council <u>every 6 months</u> on the implementation by the parties of resolution 1559 (2004).

The report of the Secretary-General dated 24 October 2007 (S/2007/629) is before the Security Council.

#### Middle East (Lebanon) – resolution 1595 (2005)

Resolution 1748 (2007) of 27 March 2007

Para. 3: requests the International Independent Investigation Commission (IIIC) to continue to report to the Security Council on the progress of the investigation <u>every four months</u>, or at any other time as it deems appropriate.

The IIIC report is expected to be issued by 27 November 2007.

#### **Security Council mission to Timor-Leste**

Security Council members are expected to undertake a mission to Timor-Leste during the last week of November 2007.

#### EUROPE

#### Bosnia and Herzegovina – Peace Agreement

Resolution 1722 (2006) of 21 November 2005

Para. 21: requests the Secretary-General to continue to submit to the Security Council reports from the High Representative, in accordance with Annex 10 of the Peace Agreement and the conclusions of the Peace Implementation Conference held in London on 4 and 5 December 1996 (S/1996/1012) and later Peace Implementation Conferences, on the implementation of the Peace Agreement.

The Secretary-General is expected to transmit the report of the High Representative to the Security Council by 14 November 2007.

#### Bosnia and Herzegovina – EUFOR

Resolution 1722 (2006) of 21 November 2006

Para. 10: authorizes the Member States acting through or in cooperation with the European Union to establish <u>for a further period of 12 months</u>, starting from the date of the adoption of the resolution, a multinational stabilization force (EUFOR).

The authorization to EUFOR will expire on 21 November 2007.

#### Cyprus - UNFICYP

Resolution 1758 (2007) of 15 June 2007

Para. 8: requests the Secretary-General to submit a report on implementation of the resolution by 1 December 2007.

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued by 1 December 2007.

#### OTHER

#### Security sector reform

S/PRST/2007/3 of 20 January 2007

Last para.: welcomes the joint initiative of Slovakia and South Africa to further discuss this issue with a focus on experiences and challenges of security sector reform in Africa at a workshop to be held in the course of 2007.

The workshop is scheduled to be held in Cape Town from 7 to 8 November 2007.

## Coordinated reporting by Chairmen of counter-terrorism committees S/PRST/2005/34 of 20 July 2005

Last para.: invites the Committee established pursuant to resolution 1267 (1999) concerning Al-Qaida and the Taliban and associated individuals and entities, the Committee established pursuant to resolution 1373 (2001) concerning counter-terrorism (CTC), and the Committee established pursuant to resolution 1540 (2004) to continue reporting on their activities at regular intervals and, where appropriate, in a coordinated manner.

#### Resolution 1735 (2006) of 22 December 2006

Para. 31: requests the Committee established pursuant to resolution 1267 (1999) concerning Al-Qaida and the Taliban and associated individuals and entities to report orally, through its Chairman, to the Security Council <u>at least every 180 days</u> on the overall work of the Committee and the Analytical Support and Sanctions Monitoring Team and, as appropriate, <u>in conjunction with the reports by the Chairmen of the CTC and of the Committee established pursuant to resolution 1540 (2004).</u>

#### S/PRST/2006/56 of 20 December 2006

Calls on the Committee established pursuant to resolution 1373 (2001) concerning counterterrorism to report on the status of implementation of resolution 1373 (2001) and encourages the Committee particularly to report to the Council on any outstanding issues, when necessary and on a regular basis, in order to receive strategic guidance from the Council.

The Chairmen of the Committees established pursuant to resolutions 1267 (1999), 1373 (2001) and 1540 (2004) are expected to give a joint briefing to the Security Council <u>during</u> November 2007.

#### Protection of civilians in armed conflict

#### Resolution 1674 (2006) of 28 April 2006

Para. 27: requests the Secretary-General to submit his next report on the protection of civilians in armed conflict within 18 months of the date of this resolution.

#### Resolution 1738 (2006) of 23 December 2006

Para. 12: requests the Secretary-General to include as a sub-item in his next reports on the protection of civilians in armed conflict the issue of the safety and security of journalists, media professionals and associated personnel.

The report of the Secretary-General dated 28 October 2007 (S/2007/643) is before the Security Council.

#### S/PRST/2002/41 of 20 December 2002

Welcomes the oral briefings to be given to the Security Council every 6 months.

The next oral briefing is expected to be given during November 2007.

## Conflict prevention and resolution, particularly in Africa

S/PRST/2007/31 of 28 August 2007

Para. 3: requests the Secretary-General to report to the Security Council within 60 days on options for further implementation of its resolution 1625 (2005).

Annual Report of the Security Council to the General Assembly

The President of the Security Council is expected to introduce the Annual Report in the General Assembly on 12 November 2007.
