

**TENTATIVE FORECAST OF THE PROGRAMME OF WORK OF THE  
SECURITY COUNCIL FOR THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY 2012**

For information only/not an official document

This tentative forecast of the programme of work of the Security Council has been prepared by the Secretariat for the President of the Council. The forecast covers in particular those matters that may be taken up during the month pursuant to earlier decisions of the Council. The fact that a matter is or is not included in the forecast carries no implication that it will or will not be taken up during the month: the actual programme of work will be determined by developments and the views of members of the Council.

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**AFRICA**

**Democratic Republic of the Congo - MONUSCO**

Resolution 1991 (2011) of 28 June 2011

Para.23: requests the Secretary-General to report in October 2011, in January 2012 and by the 23 May 2012 on the progress on the ground, further requests the Secretary-General to regularly brief and inform it on the significant events of the electoral process, including on MONUSCO's support to this process, and to provide a comprehensive assessment of the political, security, humanitarian and human rights environment following the elections, and requests the Secretary-General to provide in these reports an indication of progress towards achieving a coordinated United Nations approach in-country, and in particular on critical gaps to achieving peacebuilding objectives alongside the mission;

The report of the Secretary-General dated 26 January 2012 (S/2012//65) is before the Security Council.

**Libya – UNSMIL**

Resolution 2009 (2011) of 16 September 2011

Para. 22: requests the Secretary-General to report on implementation of this resolution in 14 days from adoption, and every month thereafter, or more frequently as he sees fit.

The Secretary-General is expected to report to the Council during February 2012.

**Libya – sanctions**

Resolution 1973 (2011) of 17 March 2011

Para. 24: requests the Secretary-General to create for an initial period of one year, in consultation with the Committee, a group of up to eight experts ("Panel of Experts"), under the direction of the Committee to carry out the following tasks:

d): provide to the Council an interim report on its work no later than 90 days after the Panel's appointment, and a final report to the Council no later than 30 days prior to the termination of its mandate with its findings and recommendations;

The Chairman of the 1973 Committee is expected to report to the Security Council during February 2012

**Somalia - AMISOM**

Resolution 2010 (2011) of 30 September 2011

Para. 29: requests the Secretary-General to report on all aspects of this resolution every four months and expresses its intention to review the situation, as part of his reporting obligations, as specified in the statement of the President of the Security Council of 31 October 2001 (S/PRST/2001/30) and Security Council resolutions, 1863 (2009), 1872 (2009), 1910 (2010) and 1964 (2010);

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued during February 2012

### **Somalia – piracy**

Resolution 2015 (2011) of 24 October 2011

Para. 16: requests that the Secretary-General, in conjunction with UNODC and UNDP, further consult with Somalia and regional States willing to establish anti-piracy courts on the kind of international assistance, including the provision of international personnel, that would be required to help make such courts operational; the procedural arrangements required for transfer of apprehended pirates and related evidence; the projected case capacity of such courts; and the projected timeline and costs for such courts, and to provide to the Council in the light of such consultations within 90 days detailed implementation proposals for the establishment of such courts, as appropriate;

The report of the Secretary-General dated 20 January 2012 (S/2012/50) is before the Security Council.

### **The Sudan - Panel of experts**

Resolution 1982 (2011) of 17 May 2011

Para. 3: decides to extend until 19 February 2012 the mandate of the Panel of Experts, originally appointed pursuant to resolution 1591 (2005) and previously extended by resolutions 1691 (2005), 1665 (2006), 1713 (2006), 1779 (2007), 1841 (2008), 1891 (2009) and 1945 (2010), and requests the Secretary-General to take the necessary administrative measures as expeditiously as possible.

The Panel of Experts mandate will expire on 19 February 2012.

Para: 4: requests the Panel of Experts to provide a final report no later than 30 days prior to termination of its mandate to the Council with findings and recommendations,

### **The Sudan - UNISFA**

Resolution 1990 (2011) of 27 June 2011

Para. 11: requests the Secretary-General to keep the Council regularly informed of the progress in implementing the Agreement and to report to the Council no later than thirty days after the adoption of this resolution and every 60 days thereafter;

The report of the Secretary-General dated 27 January 2012 (S/2012/68) is before the Security Council.

## ASIA

### **The situation in the Middle East, including the Palestinian question**

Resolution 1322 (2000) of 7 October 2000

Para. 7: invites the Secretary-General to continue to follow the situation and to keep the Security Council informed.

### **Middle East – Lebanon (resolution 1701 (2006))**

Resolution 2004 (2011) of 30 August 2011

Para.10. requests the Secretary-General to continue to report to the Council on the implementation of resolution 1701 (2006), every four months, or at any time as he deems appropriate.

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued in February 2012.

### **Middle East – Yemen**

In the press statement of 25 January 2012 members of the Security Council reaffirmed their intention to continue to actively monitor the security, political and humanitarian situation in Yemen and the implementation of Security Council resolution 2014 (2011). They looked forward to an update on the situation within 30 days, including on the status of the implementation of the political transition agreements.

### **Timor-Leste – UNMIT**

Resolution 1969 (2011) of 24 February 2011

Para. 1: decides to extend the mandate of the United Nations Integrated Mission in Timor-Leste (UNMIT) until 26 February 2012.

The UNMIT mandate will expire on 26 February 2012.

Para. 19: requests also the Secretary-General to keep the Security Council regularly informed of the developments on the ground and to submit to the Security Council, no later than 15 October 2011 and 26 January 2012, reports that include an update regarding the High Level Committee on Transition and progress concerning the critical tasks that will need to be accomplished post-election, and on planning concerning the United Nations presence in Timor-Leste beyond 2012 elections;

The report of the Secretary-General dated 18 January 2012 (S/2012/43) is before the Security Council.

## EUROPE

**Resolutions 1160 (1998), 1199 (1998), 1203 (1998), 1239 (1999) and 1244 (1999) – UNMIK**  
Resolution 1244 (1999) of 10 June 1999

Para. 20: requests the Secretary-General to report to the Security Council at regular intervals on the implementation of the resolution.

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued in early February 2012.

**OTHER**

**Non-proliferation / DPRK**

Resolution 1718 (2006) of 14 October 2006

Para. 12(g): decides that the Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006) shall report at least every 90 days to the Security Council on its work, with its observations and recommendations, in particular on ways to strengthen the effectiveness of the measures imposed by paragraph 8 of the resolution.

The Chairman of the 1718 Committee is expected to report to the Security Council during February 2011.

Sudan - UNMISS	Early March 2012	Resolution 1996 (2011) of 8 July 2011	“(…)Requests Secretary- General, following consultations with the Government of the Republic of South Sudan, to present benchmarks for the mission to the Council within four months, and to keep the Council regularly informed of progress every four months thereafter.”(para. 19).
Haiti	During March 2012	Resolution 2012 (2011) of 14 October 2011	“Requests the Secretary-General to report to the Council on the implementation of MINUSTAH’s mandate, semi-annually and not later than 45 days prior to its expiration”. (para.23).

Iraq – oil for food	No later than 31 March 2012	Resolution 1958 (2010) of 15 December 2010	“Requests the Secretary-General to report and provide analysis to the Council on the usage and expenditure of the escrow account referenced in paragraphs 4 and 5 on an annual basis, the first no later than 31 March 2012, with the final report occurring three months after the transfer of any remaining funds retained for the purposes of paragraphs 4 and 5 to the Government of Iraq by 31 December 2016, unless otherwise authorized by the Security Council”.
