This tentative forecast of the programme of work of the Security Council has been prepared by the Secretariat for the President of the Council. The forecast covers in particular those matters that may be taken up during the month pursuant to earlier decisions of the Council. The fact that a matter is or is not included in the forecast carries no implication that it will or will not be taken up during the month: the actual programme of work will be determined by developments and the views of members of the Council.

AFRICA

Central African Region – United Nations Office for Central Africa (UNOCA)

Letter from the President of the Security Council dated 30 August 2010 (S/2010/457)

Proposed that the office be established for an initial period of two years, with a review of its mandate after 18 months.

The UNOCA mandate will expire on 30 August 2012.

Peace and security in Africa – Mali

Resolution 2056 (2012) of 5 July 2012

Para. 27: requests the Secretary-General to report, by 31 July 2012, on the situation in Mali and the implementation of this resolution, possible steps to ensure the effective full restoration of constitutional order and of the territorial integrity in Mali, including the detailed options referred to in paragraph 18 above and prepared through the cooperation between the Commission of ECOWAS, the Commission of the AU, and countries in the region, with the support of the United Nations, and ways of improving international coordination.

Para. 28: requests the Secretary-General to develop and implement, in consultation with regional organizations, a United Nations integrated strategy for the Sahel region encompassing security, governance, development, human rights and humanitarian issues, including through the involvement of the United Nations Office for West Africa, and requests the Secretary-General to inform the Council on progress made by 15 September 2012.

The Secretary-General is expected to report to the Security Council during August 2012.

The Sudan (Sudan/South Sudan)

Resolution 2046 (2012) of 2 May 2012

Para. 5: Decides that the negotiations referred to in paragraph 2 above shall be concluded within three months of the adoption of this resolution, and in the event these negotiations fail to result in an agreement on any or all of the issues within the allotted timeframe of three months, requests the Secretary-General, in consultation with the AUHIP, the Chair of IGAD, and the Chairman of the AU Commission, to report within four months of the date of this resolution to the Security Council on the status of the negotiations, including detailed proposals on all outstanding issues.

The Secretary-General is expected to report to the Security Council by 2 September 2012.

Para. 6: Requests the Secretary-General to consult with the African Union on the implementation of this resolution and the decisions of the AU PSC, to work closely with the AUHIP in support of its facilitation efforts, and to inform the Security Council within 15 days and in two week intervals thereafter on the status of compliance by Sudan, South Sudan, and the

SPLM-N with the decisions set forth in this resolution, and expresses its intention, in the event that any or all of the parties have not complied with the decisions set forth in this resolution, to take appropriate additional measures under Article 41 of the Charter as necessary.

The Secretary-General is expected to report to the Security Council in August 2012.

The Sudan – UNISFA

Resolution 2047 (2012) of 17 May 2012

Para 15: Requests the Secretary-General to continue to inform the Council of progress in implementing UNISFA's mandate in 60 day intervals, and continue to bring to the Council's immediate attention any serious violations of the above referenced agreements.

The report of the Secretary-General dated 25 July 2012 (S/2012/583) is before the Security Council.

AMERICAS

Haiti – (MINUSTAH)

Resolution 2012 (2011) of 14 October 2011

Para. 23: Requests the Secretary-General to report to the Council on the implementation of mandate of the United Nations Stabilization Mission in Haiti (MINUSTAH) semi-annually and not later than 45 days prior to its expiration.

Para. 24: Requests the Secretary-General to include in his reports a comprehensive assessment of threats to security in Haiti and give particular attention to the protective environment for all, in particular women and children, and on progress in the sustainable resettlement of displace persons, and to propose, as appropriate, options to reconfigure the composition of MINUSTAH.

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued by 31 August 2012.

ASIA

The situation in the Middle East, including the Palestinian Question

Resolution 1322 (2000) of 7 October 2000

Para. 7: invites the Secretary-General to continue to follow the situation and to keep the Security Council informed.

Middle East (UNIFIL)

Resolution 2004 (2011) of 30 August 2011

Para. 1: decides to extend the present mandate of UNIFIL until 31 August 2012.

The UNIFIL mandate will expire on 31 August 2012.

A meeting of the Security Council and the troop-contributing countries is expected to take place in mid-August 2012.

Middle East – Syria/UNSMIS

Resolution 2059 (2012) of 20 July 2012

Para. 1: decides to renew the mandate of UNSMIS for a final period of 30 days, taking into consideration the Secretary-General's recommendations to reconfigure the Mission, and taking into consideration the operational implications of the increasingly dangerous security situation in Syria;

The UNSMIS mandate will expire on 19 August 2012.

Para. 4: requests the Secretary-General to report to the Council on the implementation of this resolution within 15 days;

The Secretary-General is expected to report to the Security Council in August 2012.

Middle East – Syria

S/PRST/2012/6 of 21 March 2012

Last para.: Requests the Envoy to update the Council regularly and in a timely manner on the progress of his mission.

The Envoy is expected to report in August 2012.

UN Regional Centre for Preventive Diplomacy in Central Asia

Letter from the President of the Security Council dated 15 May 2007 (S/2007/280)

Invites the Secretary-General to inform members of the Security Council about the activities of the United Nations Regional Centre for Preventive Diplomacy in Ashgabat and its impact on the ground.

The Security Council is expected to receive an update during August 2012.

EUROPE

Resolutions 1160 (1998), 1199 (1998), 1203 (1998), 1239 (1999) and 1244 (1999) – UNMIK Resolution 1244 (1999) of 10 June 1999

Para. 20: requests the Secretary-General to report to the Security Council at regular intervals on the implementation of the resolution.

The report of the Secretary-General dated xx July 2012 (S/2012/xx) is before the Security Council.

OTHER

Non-proliferation / DPRK

Resolution 1718 (2006) of 14 October 2006

Para. 12(g): decides that the Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006) shall report at least every 90 days to the Security Council on its work, with its observations and recommendations, in particular on ways to strengthen the effectiveness of the measures imposed by paragraph 8 of the resolution.

The Chairman of the 1718 Committee is expected to report to the Security Council during August 2012.

Security Council Annual Report

Note by the President of the Security Council of 26 July 2010 (S/2010/507)

Para. 71(a): The draft introduction to the Annual Report of the Security Council to the General Assembly should continue to be prepared under the leadership and responsibility of the President of the Council for the month of July of each calendar year.

The drafting of the introduction to the Annual Report is expected to continue during August 2012.
