Third report of the Secretary-General pursuant to paragraph 6 of resolution 1936 (2010) (S/2011/435)

The President: In accordance with rule 37 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure, I invite the representative of Iraq to participate in this meeting.

The Security Council will now begin its consideration of the item on its agenda.

Members have before them document S/2011/465, containing the text of a draft resolution submitted by the United States of America.

I wish to draw the attention of Council members to document S/2011/435, containing the third report of the Secretary-General pursuant to paragraph 6 of resolution 1936 (2010). I also wish to draw the attention of Council members to document S/2011/464, containing a note verbale dated 27 July 2011 from the Permanent Mission of Iraq to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General.

It is my understanding that the Council is ready to proceed to the vote on the draft resolution before it.

I shall put the draft resolution to the vote now.
