**Letter dated 6 July 2007 from the President of the Security Council
to the Secretary-General**

I have the honour to inform you that your letter dated 25 June 2007 (S/2007/412), concerning security and operational issues related to the work of the United Nations Assistance Mission for Iraq, has been brought to the attention of the Security Council.

By way of a statement made by the President of the Security Council to the press on 13 June 2007 on their behalf, the members of the Security Council expressed their appreciation for ongoing United Nations support in Iraq and encouraged continued and robust United Nations assistance in support of the Iraqi people and Government.

The Council hereby confirms that it welcomes and supports the announced immediate planning for the construction of a new United Nations compound in Baghdad and has no objection to your intention to proceed with a request to the General Assembly for the necessary funds, in accordance with the established procedure.
