Letter dated 3 April 2013 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 2095 (2013) concerning Libya, adopted on 14 March 2013, by which the Council decided to extend the mandate of the Panel of Experts, established by paragraph 24 of resolution 1973 (2011) and extended by resolution 2040 (2012), for a period of 13 months.

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that I have appointed the following experts to serve on the Panel of Experts:

I have also designated Mr. Raad to serve as Coordinator of the Panel of Experts. A fifth expert will be proposed shortly.
