**Letter dated 7 September 2011 from the Secretary-General  
addressed to the President of the Security Council**

By its resolution 1774 (2007) of 14 September 2007, the Security Council reappointed Mr. Hassan Bubacar Jallow as Prosecutor of the International Criminal Tribunal for Rwanda. Pursuant to resolution 1774 (2007) and the Statute of the International Tribunal, the term of office of Mr. Jallow will come to an end on 14 September 2011.

According to article 15, paragraph 4, of the statute of the Tribunal, the Prosecutor is appointed by the Security Council on nomination by the Secretary-General and shall serve a four-year term.

In this regard, I hereby nominate Mr. Hassan Bubacar Jallow and request that the Security Council reappoint him as Prosecutor of the International Criminal Tribunal for Rwanda. The appointment should be effective 15 September 2011, for a four-year term, subject to an earlier termination by the Security Council in view of the expectation that the International Tribunal will complete its work before the expiry of the four-year term.
