- S/RES/1940 (29 September 2010) was the Security Council's decision to terminate the remaining sanctions, contained in paragraphs 2, 4 and 5 of resolution 1171 (1998), and to dissolve the Committee established pursuant to resolution 1132 (1997) concerning Sierra Leone (chaired in 2010 by HE Nawaf Salam (Lebanon)).
