Letter dated 31 October 2014 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

By its resolution 2007 (2011) of 14 September 2011, the Security Council reappointed Serge Brammertz as Prosecutor of the International Tribunal for the former Yugoslavia. Pursuant to that resolution, the term of office of Mr. Brammertz will come to an end on 31 December 2014.

In accordance with article 16, paragraph 4, of the statute of the Tribunal, the Prosecutor is appointed by the Security Council on nomination by the Secretary-General.

In that regard, I hereby nominate Mr. Brammertz and request that the Security Council reappoint him as Prosecutor of the International Tribunal for the former Yugoslavia. Given the projection of the President of the Tribunal, Judge Theodor Meron, in regard to the completion of the work of the Tribunal in 2017, I suggest that you, and through you the Council, consider the extension of the appointment of Mr. Brammertz for a term with effect from 1 January 2015 until 31 July 2017, subject to an earlier termination by the Council upon the completion of the work of the Tribunal.
