Letter dated 30 March 2015 from the Secretary-General to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 2207 (2015), by which the Council decided to extend until 5 April 2016 the mandate of the Panel of Experts, as specified in paragraph 26 of resolution 1874 (2009), and requested me to take the necessary administrative measures to that effect.

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that, after consulting with the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006), I have appointed the following experts:

- Mr. Benoît Camguilhem, missile technology (France)
- Mr. Katsuhisa Furukawa, nuclear issues (Japan)
- Mr. Hugh Griffiths, air transport (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland)
- Mr. Dmitry Kiku, customs and export controls (Russian Federation)
- Mr. Youngwan Kim, weapons of mass destruction arms control and non-proliferation policy (Republic of Korea)
- Ms. Stephanie Kleine-Ahlbrandt, finance (United States of America)
- Mr. Neil Watts, maritime transport (South Africa)
- Mr. Jiahu Zong, other weapons of mass destruction and conventional arms (China).

I have designated Mr. Hugh Griffiths to serve as Coordinator of the Panel of Experts.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
