Letter dated 14 March 2018 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution [2400 \(2018\)](#) of 8 February 2018, by which the Council decided to extend the mandate of the Panel of Experts on the Sudan until 12 March 2019.

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that, after consulting with the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution [1591 \(2005\)](#) concerning the Sudan, I have appointed the following experts:

- Ms. Priscilla Ciesay, international humanitarian law (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland)
- Mr. Vincent Darracq, arms and armed groups (France)
- Mr. Thomas Bifwoli Wanjala, transport and customs (Kenya)
- Mr. Rajeev Yadav, finance (India)

One additional expert will be appointed shortly.

I have designated Mr. Wanjala to serve as Coordinator of the Panel of Experts.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
