Letter dated 29 June 2018 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to your letter dated 26 June 2018 ([S/2018/627](#)) concurring with my proposal to reappoint 23 judges of the International Residual Mechanism for Criminal Tribunals.

I have received a corresponding letter from the President of the General Assembly (see annex I). Accordingly, I am proceeding with the reappointment of the 23 judges of the Mechanism. A list of the judges is set out in annex II to the present letter.

In accordance with paragraph 2 of Security Council resolution [2269 \(2016\)](#) of 29 February 2016, the judges will be reappointed for a two-year term commencing on 1 July 2018 and expiring on 30 June 2020.

I will also proceed to reappoint Judge Theodor Meron (United States of America) as President of the Mechanism from 1 July 2018 to 18 January 2019, and to appoint Judge Carmel Agius (Malta) as President of the Mechanism from 19 January 2019 to 30 June 2020.

I should be grateful if you would bring the present letter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
