

Letter dated 28 February 2019 from the Permanent Representative of the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to write to you, in your capacity as President of the Security Council for the month of February 2019, further to the discussions that took place on 26 February 2019 during the briefing of the Council on "the situation in the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela".

With more than 24 hours already having passed since the meeting in question, I wish to respectfully request the good offices of the Security Council, through you, to call upon the delegation of Colombia to submit for circulation "the protocols of the operation that took place on Saturday", 23 February 2019, on the Colombia-Venezuela border, together with the photographs and other documentation referred to in its statement on that occasion.
