Note by the Secretary-General

1. The present note is issued in accordance with the prorating procedures approved by the General Assembly in its resolution 50/221 B. The annex to the note reflects the resources to be approved by the General Assembly in respect of each peacekeeping mission, including the prorated shares of the support account and of the United Nations Logistics Base at Brindisi, Italy.
